

# Manual: Create an Adobe Account & Generate PDF Embed API Credentials

## Step 1: Go to Adobe Acrobat Services API

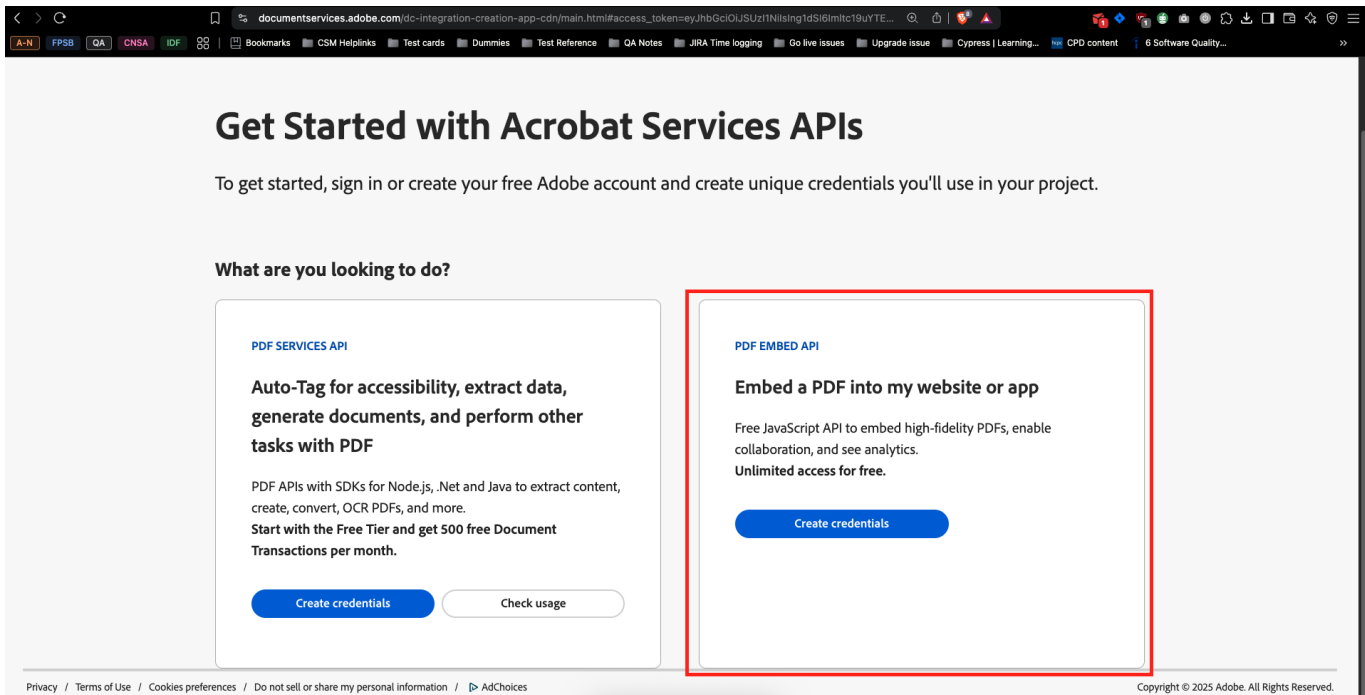
Visit: <https://documentservices.adobe.com/>

You'll see two options under 'What are you looking to do?'

Select the 'PDF Embed API' option on the right, then click 'Create credentials.'

Don't have an Adobe account?

Click the Sign In button in the top-right corner, then select 'Create an account'. You can create a free Adobe account using your email, Google, Apple, or Facebook login.



## Step 2: Fill Out Credential Details

You'll be directed to a form titled 'Create new credentials'.

- Credentials Name: Enter a name to describe your site/project (e.g., MyPDFViewer).
- Application Domain: Enter the domain where you'll use the viewer (e.g., mywebsite.com).

Note: Credentials are domain-specific. Use a wildcard or create separate credentials for each subdomain if

Check the box to agree to Adobe's developer terms, then click 'Create credentials'.

Once created, Adobe will display:

- Client ID (API Key): Required for integrating the PDF Embed API into your site.
- Application Domain: The domain you entered earlier.

Click the 'Copy' button to save your Client ID.
